Weisgram took the honors for Best Check Silesian with a Blue, Mike Swanson walked away with Best Young Blue Check Silesian, Best Silver Barless Silesian and rounded out his winnings with Best Fairy Swallow and that was with a Blue White Bar. But, nothing was more impressive than the achievements made by our junior member Kaylee Skistimas out of Missouri... WOW!!! What a performance by a dedicated fancier...six entries resulting in three 94's, two 95's and one 96. She took the awards for Best Silver Check and Young Silver Check. This is an incredible performance and I applaud her accomplishments!!! Good job Kaylee!

Before closing, I also want to single out and personally thank two gentlemen for their continuous services to our USC – Elliot Yeske for his extraordinary accomplishments as our Secretary/Treasurer. Elliot is never getting a break from his duties. Memorial Show a Benson Win

The 2012 USC Annual meet and Bob Benson Memorial Show is in the record book. What is not recorded is that Bob had one last hurrah, one last laugh so to speak!

To set the record straight, Mike and Kathy Swanson purchased all of Bob Benson's birds from his wife, Betty, with the exception one young blue check # 309 that I took home. With help from Nancy Pinke and her husband Dave, Bill Tietze, Mary and myself along with Bob's kids, we took down the lofts, salvaged the perches and other stuff and loaded up the birds. Once home, Mike evaluated Bob's birds and distributed about half to fellow Colorado Pigeon Club members, dividing the quality equally. Mike's thinking was that breeders would have a good chance to raise superior birds and keep the bloodline going.

When Bob's memorial show was planned, I encouraged these Colorado breeders to show that last round of Bob's birds along with what they raised over breeding season. Most of the Colorado breeders came to Des Moines, some with Bob's last round and others with nice young silver and blue checks. It was a most beautiful display of checkered swallows and something Bob would have loved to see!

The memorial part of the show and checker judging was held Friday night. Bob's loft jacket hung on an empty chair, his master breeders certificate layed on a table for everyone to see. The show sign read "Bob Benson Memorial Show" and pigeon folk stopped by to pay their respects or tell a story or two; others were shocked and unaware of Bob's passing.

There were new faces at the show including Dave Averbeck, our Central District director, the Colorado boys, and some new members who were recent additions to the club!

The checker judging was held like a separate show. Gary Romig had his work cut out for him and did a fine job of rating the birds, though it was no easy task. All of the birds were very nice. In fact, there wasn't a "G" rated checker in the bunch which is unusual. Kaylee Skistimas, with her own line of checkers, had the best silver young checker, best silver check and young checker overall with a young hen. Mike Swanson had a terrific blue checker that was the best young blue, also a hen. J.T. Cashman, Frank Walsh and Rob Cranwell and Rolly Parrott were competitive with their respective entries and most of the time, as we watched the judging, we were never quite sure just whose bird would come out on top! To my surprise, blue checker # 309 turned out to be the bird of the day and best checker of the memorial show! Because I had already given the bird to Mike Swanson, I presented the award and the Hans Schipper donated painting to Mike and the Colorado crew where it belonged!

The following morning the show continued with more great birds and high ratings! Perry Mueller had the best bird of the show with an "E" rated Blue Barless Silesian!

It was a great show with beautiful swallows, fine competition and wonderful fellowship, like the early Des Moines shows held downtown in the old civic center, back when Howard Hart was alive...much like the shows Bob loved 20 some years ago when he started in checkers.

In a twist of fate, Bob Benson actually won his own memorial show. We laughed about that after the fact. Congratulations, Bob! You were and still are a great inspiration! As for the rest of us, we better get going on our next season. Rumor has it there are some special awards for checkers next year! Best of luck, everyone, in 2013!
