2015 United Swallow Club Annual Meeting Minutes

The United Swallow Club's annual meeting was called to order by Vice-President Gary Romig at 12 noon on Friday, November 20, 2015. Gary asked Bill Griebel if he would take the minutes of the meeting and Bill agreed.

Gary then read the treasurer's report supplied to him by our Secretary/Treasurer Elliot Yeske. The treasury had \$4132.28 in it at the time.

Gary then read the minutes from the previous meeting taken at the NPA National in January, 2015. The minutes were accepted as read.

Gary asked Bill Griebel to give a report on the status of the Certified Judging Program. Bill reported the program had just been updated by the members of the program and Nate Wayne had just been voted in as our newest Certified Judge. We all congratulated Nate.

Gary then talked about the USC banners to be displayed at our district meets and our annual shows. Banners will be sent to the district directors of each district.

At this point, Gary asked Bill to talk about the silent auction. Bill discussed how the silent auction operates and all monies collected for the sale of Swallows would be split 50/50 between USC and SCCPC. All the monies

It was then brought up that we might consider making Merle Starr a lifetime USC member. Leon Stephens made a motion to make Merle a lifetime member. The motion was seconded by Nate Wayne. The motion passed unanimously.

The subject was brought up about nominations for the 2016 USC Annual meet show and judge. Vancouver, Washington was nominated for our 2016 USC Annual Meet by Frank Bailey. Frank indicated he was still working on a judge.

Gary Romig then asked Nate Wayne to talk about the possibility of having a USC futurity. Nate then discussed the highlights of the program. A long discussion resulted by members present. The members agreed there needs to be more suggestions. Steve Ball made a motion that we accept the futurity concept but more refinement would be necessary. The motion passed. Steve Ball then made a motion the USC Executive Board define the rules for the futurity and then put these rules in print for the membership to review and possibly make further suggestions and then vote on it. The motion passed.

Although the process started out slow (due to my schedule) the 3 of them and myself went to work in earnest in the fall of 2015 and have come up with a draft that we would like your input on BEFORE a version is submitted for a vote of the membership.

Although there are no real radical changes there are changes throughout the whole document and some of the current modifications are the result of multiple rewrites until we came up with wording that we felt best represented current practices/procedures and also made sense.

I area where I believe help is needed is Article IX - Standards. If anyone knows the dates when the standards

on our website were written and adopted I would appreciate getting that information so that I can formalize and document those dates within the Constitution and By-Laws.

It would also help me and the committee out if you would send any feedback to me (or Ron, Leon or David) within the next couple of weeks so that we could make any necessary changes before the official vote is requested in the next club bulletin (along with the annual show and judge). You will be receiving a copy of the modified Const/By-laws either with this bulletin or in a separate email/mailing shortly thereafter.
