

By now everyone should be off to a good start with their breeding. I'm starting to band the second round now, before you know it the season will be over. At this time we will be having two meets in our district, one at Louisville in October and one in Des Moines in December. I will give further details in the next bulletin on dates and times. I understand that Des Moines might possibly be our annual meeting.

Good luck to everyone this year.

The Judges Corner

Several things to think about: One, you trainee judges need to get your judging info to me as soon as you can. I know there are a few of you out there, Dave, George, Mike and others who need to do this to get credit for your efforts.

Second, I want to emphasize how important the walk-around process is to our judging program. I've seen several judges get themselves in a corner by not doing a walk-around. Many times, we start our judging with the weaker classes and if the judge starts the ratings on the high side then the rest of the ratings at times will tend to be higher. This makes for a show with most of the ratings top heavy on the high side. Or a judge may start with low ratings and may stay low. What we should strive for is a range in the ratings from top to bottom. Some judges put a mark on the coop card that is turned around top note the birds he or she thinks might be the higher rated birds and asks the scribe to alert them to those marks. Use whatever system works for you but remember, when the coop card is brought up front with the bird, the judge should never look at it.

Third, when a certified judge is ready to assign an "E" and is not quite sure about the procedure (there are three options by the way) there is information in our certified judges program on line outlining these procedures. The Certified Judge and the "person in charge" should have a copy of this at the show for reference.

Select a second judge that is void of as many conflicts as possible. Sometimes some conflicts are unavoidable or if there are too many conflicts the judge can choose not to award an "E". Remember, at no time can a USC Certified Judge at an USC Annual Meet award an "E" without a second judge's approval.

Just a few thoughts to help our new prospective judges proceed in the judging training process.

Now it's Question and Survey time. Question: Can a lesser quality bird (a bird from a color/marking group, say red or yellow) beat a better quality bird? My answer is that the lesser quality bird should not. A judge has the option to award a lesser quality bird (a bird with a higher "degree of difficulty" in breeding) a higher rating. This is why a walk-around is so important, the judge will be able to see the overall quality of the show and NOT get themselves in a corner that they can't get out. Caution, going too high on a lessor bird can get them into other problems when awarding Res. Champ, BOS or Best Young.

Survey: If you have a non USC Certified Judge judging a USC meet and they feel a bird should get the "E" rating can two USC Certified Judges who are at the show with little or no conflicts be called in to award an "E"?
