The Pageant of Pigeons will be held November 17-18, 2017. The next show is the Iowa State Pigeon Association's Pigeon's on the Prairie in Des Moines, Iowa December 8-9, 2017. USC member Perry Mueller will be the member-in-charge for the Iowa State Pigeon Assn. show. Entries are due November 7, 2017 and with an additional \$1.00 per entry you can enter as late as November 14, 2017.

Lastly, our 'season showcase' will be our USC Annual Show at the NPA Grand National in Amarillo, Texas in Jan. 18, 19, 20, 2018.

road in North America. Enroute to the summit you gain 7,000 feet in elevation during the 28 mile drive! The road was built during the Great Depression as one of many Conservation Corps projects. At the base of Mount Evans we explored the town of Idaho Springs. We had a great lunch at Tommy Knockers, a local brewery. Tommy Knocker is a legend among the gold and silver miners. Then we toured a mining museum across the street and maximized the photo opportunity in front of Elliott's, a local clothing emporium. We laughed as Mike took our group photo and thought fellow member and world traveler Elliot Yeske, should be part of our photo as well! We enjoyed our fun in the mountains and then headed back to Denver. Sandy and Dave planned to meet Sandy's son and grandchildren the next day in Castle Rock, Colorado.
