Greg Volzke Swallows to Storks!

Now that breeding season is in full swing, I will make my appeal for stock birds for my Stork projects.

It was brought to my attention at the Iowa show that the European Storks are maintained through crosses with Swallows. I have not been able to obtain the swallows I need for a long time and have lost some of the qualities needed in the Storks. If the Swallow club could support the Storks with stock birds, I feel a partnership between the breeds could expand involvement for both breeds.

Specifically, I need barless red and black, Silesian and Fairy Swallows. I would love to get birds that are under marked and not usable in Swallow breeding. I would also like to introduce grease quill to intensify the color. My blue and yellow birds are doing well on quality but new blood for them would also be appreciated.

My breeding season has good news and bad news. The good news is that the blue and black colors are breeding well and even producing good quality birds in the odd bird pen. The bad news is that the red and yellow Storks are few and the color needs help. I hope to have a few pair of blue and black Storks for the club auction in December.
